INTERMENT REGULATIONS

GENERAL REGULATIONS: The Purchaser, or Purchaser's authorized legal representative(s), shall schedule with Prospect Hill Cemetery of Towson, Inc. the date and time of a proposed burial within 24 hours or less of death occurrence (for non-cremation burial). Prospect Hill Cemetery of Towson, Inc. reserves the right to choose the day and time of each burial according to the cemetery's schedule of events.

GRAVE MARKERS: Only one grave monument/marker will be permitted on a grave space. A single grave monument/marker may be set to embrace two or more grave spaces. All grave monuments/markers shall be set on uniform lines as prescribed by Prospect Hill Cemetery of Towson, Inc. Grave monument/markers are to be paid for by the Purchaser, or Purchaser's authorized legal and/or representative(s). Grave monuments/markers remain the property of the Purchaser or his/her heirs. Repair, maintenance and restoration of grave monuments/markers are the responsibility of the Purchaser or his/her heirs. Grave monument/markers must be installed no later than six months following closing of a grave. Upright grave monuments are restricted and limited to the following dimensions: (1) single grave: base 36 inches long, 12 inches wide, die 30 inches high; (2) single monument, double name: base 5 feet long, 12 inches wide, die 30 inches high. Flat markers shall not exceed the following dimensions: Individual Burials 24"x12"; Double Side by Side Burials 44"x13". *Please note: Upright monuments are not permitted in part of Sections F and in Section G as well as the Memorial (Cremation) Section. Flat markers must be used within these sections and conform to the previously listed dimensions.*

BURIAL VAULTS: Burial vaults or concrete liners must be utilized.

STATE REGULATIONS: Burials must comply with all Maryland State and Baltimore County regulations.

MULTIPLE BURIALS: No grave space may contain more than three (3) urns of cremated remains with the exception of the Memorial (Cremation) Section, which can only contain one (1) urn of cremated remains per grave space.

INTERMENT RIGHTS: Interment rights shall be used for no other purpose than the burial of human dead.
