

Prospect Hill Cemetery of Towson, Inc.

Cemetery Regulations

Cemetery hours are from dawn to dusk. All visitors walk in the cemetery at their own risk. All children visiting the cemetery must be accompanied by an adult.

Prospect Hill Cemetery is not responsible for theft or damage to anything placed on graves or lots.

Cut fresh flowers (in non-breakable vases) may be placed on graves at any time. Artificial flowers may not be placed on graves from May 15th through October 15th.

Cemetery representatives reserve the right to remove from the cemetery all flowers, potted plants, wreaths, basket of flowers or anything deemed objectionable, for any reason, when it is in the best interest of the cemetery, determined in the sole and absolute discretion of the cemetery board.

Sitting, leaning on, and/or tampering with monuments is not permitted. Defacing and destruction of monuments will be prosecuted to the full extent of the law.

Skateboards, mopeds, cycles and other forms of recreational vehicles and equipment are not permitted in the cemetery.

Walking dogs or other pets is not permitted in the cemetery.

The cemetery must be contacted three business days before any services are scheduled.

No loitering or trespassing. Violators will be prosecuted to the full extent of the law.

The board of Prospect Hill Cemetery reserves the right to change or amend these regulations at any time.
